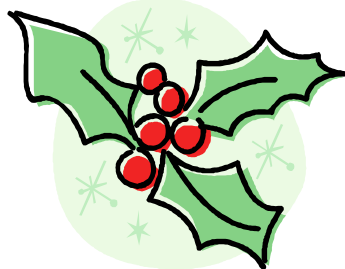




### Meet our New Administrative Assistant!

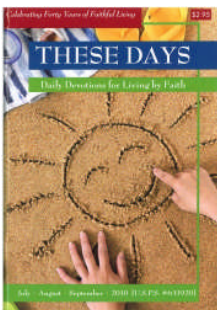
