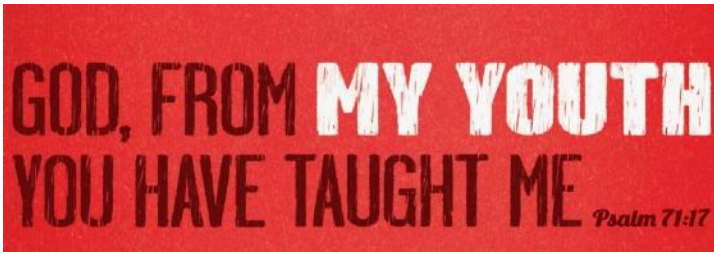
WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Don't forget your Fair Trade products this summer! Items of the month will be:

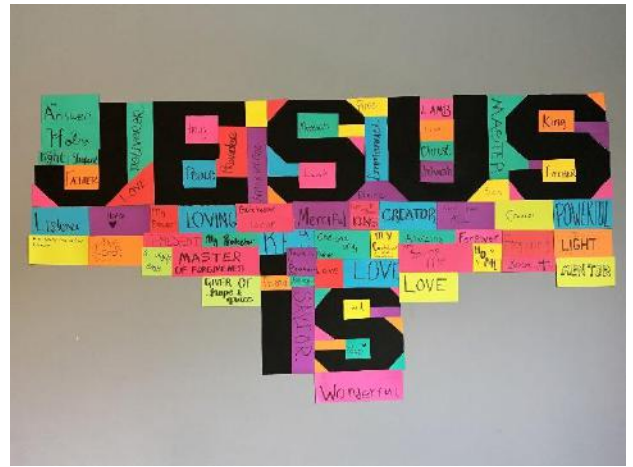
