- June – 7 hygiene kits and 1 cleanup bucket will be donated to the Presbyterian Disaster Assistance.
- July – A variety of school supplies (30 notebooks/paper, 21 boxes of crayons, 4 boxes of Kleenex, 8 hand sanitizers, 8 markers...etc.) will be donated to Randolph Elementary School. There were 77 items delivered (and 4 volunteers) who assisted the Food Pantry on July 25.
- **August – The Well Project – Thank you to those who donated their coins during our special offering on August 26! \$82.43 will join donations from other churches in Homestead Presbytery to build wells in South Sudan and Niger that will provide water and save lives.**

LINCOLN'S ANNUAL CROP WALK

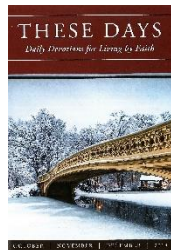
Lincoln's Annual CROP Hunger Walk will be Sunday afternoon, October
